Whether you're after a dining experience in stylish surrounds, cosy local cafés, affordable gourmet eats, or an exceptional coffee to kickstart the day, Lyneham is surrounded by superb local produce served by passionate people that fit effortlessly into your life at Northbourne Village.



Highroad by ONA Coffee in Dickson

With a focus on specialty coffee led by one of Australia's most highly regarded roasters, ONA Coffee, Highroad offers contemporary dishes from locally-sourced ingredients, in a modern 'Bush Capital' inspired setting.



The Front Café & Gallery in Lyneham

An Inner North icon that somehow feels like a well-kept secret. Serving a seasonal all day menu, The Front support local artists and showcase a rotating collection of works, all within an intimate and historic gallery space.





CLAY by Redbrick in Turner

Part of the Redbrick Coffee family—who have spent the past decade creating and sharing specialty coffee—CLAY is a cosy espresso bar on Northbourne Avenue serving small bites in a friendly atmosphere.



Tilley's Devine Café Gallery in Dickson

Named after Matilda 'Tilly' Devine—an English-Australian gangster and madame from Sydney—the café first opened in 1984. Today, you'll enjoy all day dining, live music, and art exhibitions in a warm, timber and red-accented interior lounge.



Good Brother in Dickson

Tucked between Woolley and Challis Street with a quiet outdoor area, Good Brother is busy serving locals great coffee, egg and bacon rolls, much-loved toasties, burgers, big brekkies, and freshly baked goods.







Ruby Chinese Restaurant in Dickson

Ruby is one of Canberra's original Chinese restaurants established in 1982. Specialising in live seafood, Ruby retains its reputation as the mecca of Cantonese cuisine despite barely changing its menu for a quarter of a century.



Dickson Dumpling House in Dickson

Traditional Chinese restaurant with a bustling vibe, serving handmade dumplings. Packed every night of the week, the menu is extensively diverse making it hard to narrow down without ordering more that you can eat.



SUPER BAO

Super Bao in Dickson

From simple beginnings as one of Canberra's most popular market stalls, Super Bao now serves delicious and unique steamed buns with a wide modern Australian-Asian menu inspired by traditional Chinese family recipes.



Tak Kee Roast Inn in Dickson

Crackly-skinned roast ducks hang in the window of this small and unassuming hidden gem. Opening in 1987 as the first Chinese BBQ restaurant in Canberra, Tak Kee's signature dishes and Char Siu and are much loved by in-the-know locals.



The Scholar Yum Cha & Seafood in Dickson

One of a handful of restaurants that locals flock to for their traditional Yum Cha fix. Seafood is a specialty of The Scholar, and a tank of live crustaceans and abalone awaits at the top of the tiled stairs amidst the weekend rush.


Dickson Asian Noodle House in Dickson

Jimmy's Place in Dickson



Authentic Vietnamese at a reasonable price, and freshness of taste that is so characteristic of Vietnamese cuisine. Despite its rather plain interior, this humble restaurant has been delighting locals for over a decade and a half.

The Canberra Wine House in Dickson

Inspired by a love for all things local, The Canberra Wine House hosts a magnificent wine bar, a tapas menu of entirely local produce, and bottleshop dedicated solely to wines produced within the local region.



Pilot in Ainslie

In a small dining room at the Ainslie Shops, Pilot offers the 'Pilot Menu' each night, and a set menu for lunch. Menu and drinks are forever changing to showcase seasonal produce, and nostalgic flavours in complex dishes.




The Loft Bar & Living Room in O'Connor
