HIGHROAD

Highroad by ONA Coffee in Dickson

With a focus on specialty coffee led by one of Australia's most highly regarded roasters, ONA Coffee, Highroad offers contemporary dishes from locally-sourced ingredients, in a modern 'Bush Capital' inspired setting.



THE FRONT

The Front Café & Gallery in Lyneham

An Inner North icon that somehow feels like a well-kept secret. Serving a seasonal all day menu, The Front support local artists and showcase a rotating collection of works, all within an intimate and historic gallery space.



CLAY



CLAY by Redbrick in Turner

Part of the Redbrick Coffee family—who have spent the past decade creating and sharing specialty coffee—CLAY is a cosy espresso bar on Northbourne Avenue serving small bites in a friendly atmosphere.



TILLEY'S

Tilley's Devine Café Gallery in Dickson

Named after Matilda 'Tilly' Devine — an English-Australian gangster and madame from Sydney — the café first opened in 1984. Today, you'll enjoy all day dining, live music, and art exhibitions in a warm, timber and red-accented interior lounge.



GOOD BROTHER

Good Brother in Dickson

Tucked between Woolley and Challis Street with a quiet outdoor area, Good Brother is busy serving locals great coffee, egg and bacon rolls, much-loved toasties, burgers, big brekkies, and freshly baked goods.

RUBY



Ruby Chinese Restaurant in Dickson

Ruby is one of Canberra's original Chinese restaurants established in 1982. Specialising in live seafood, Ruby retains its reputation as the mecca of Cantonese cuisine despite barely changing its menu for a quarter of a century.

DUMPLING



Dickson Dumpling House in Dickson

Traditional Chinese restaurant with a bustling vibe, serving handmade dumplings. Packed every night of the week, the menu is extensively diverse making it hard to narrow down without ordering more that you can eat.



SUPER BAO

Super Bao in Dickson

From simple beginnings as one of Canberra's most popular market stalls, Super Bao now serves delicious and unique steamed buns with a wide modern Australian-Asian menu inspired by traditional Chinese family recipes.



TAK KEE

Tak Kee Roast Inn in Dickson

Crackly-skinned roast ducks hang in the window of this small and unassuming hidden gem. Opening in 1987 as the first Chinese BBQ restaurant in Canberra, Tak Kee's signature dishes and Char Siu and are much loved by in-the-know locals.

THE SCHOLAR



The Scholar Yum Cha & Seafood in Dickson

One of a handful of restaurants that locals flock to for their traditional Yum Cha fix. Seafood is a specialty of The Scholar, and a tank of live crustaceans and abalone awaits at the top of the tiled stairs amidst the weekend rush.

NOODLE HOUSE



Dickson Asian Noodle House in Dickson



TU DO

Tu Do Vietnamese in O'Connor

This small restaurant hidden in the O'Connor Shops boasts genuine, Vietnamese cuisine. Rice paper rolls and warming Pho for Canberra's cold nights are among the favourites enjoyed in their no-frills setting, or at home.



JIMMY'S



Jimmy's Place in Dickson

A popular, long-standing restaurant serving traditional and authentic Chinese cuisine. Perfect for a quick meal after work or a get together with friends and family, experience Chinese culture and culinary mastery.

AU LAC



Au Lac in Dickson

An original vegan institution since 2000. With oodles of Asian-fusion dishes that use soy-based protein in place of animal products, Au Lac is met with enthusiasm from Canberra's meat-free eaters and meat-eaters alike.



TWO SISTERS

Two Sisters in Dickson

Named after the two siblings who operate the business and head up the kitchen, this Southeast Asian restaurant is a local staple for fresh, authentic Thai and Lao food with a relaxed ambience and friendly atmosphere.



PHO PHU QUOC

Pho Phu Quoc in Dickson

Authentic Vietnamese at a reasonable price, and freshness of taste that is so characteristic of Vietnamese cuisine. Despite its rather plain interior, this humble restaurant has been delighting locals for over a decade and a half.

TAJ AGRA



Taj Agra in Dickson

A well-loved favourite for over two decades, Taj Agra is one of Canberra's oldest Indian restaurants. Experience vibrant flavours by North-Indian native chefs, traditional methods, and subcontinental herbs and spices.

BREIZH CAFÉ



Breizh Café in Ainslie

Perfect for a long brunch or lunch, this charming little French corner serves quintessential crepes of Brittany, pastries, and galettes. Nestled in the heart of Ainslie Shops, you'd be forgiven for thinking you were on the streets of Paris.



TURKISH PIDE

Lyneham Turkish Pide & Kebabs in Lyneham

A cheerful atmosphere serving Turkish Halal dishes, including a large variety of pides and kebabs in generous portions, with fresh homemade breads and dips from an extensive menu.



MOZZARELLA

Mozzarella & Co in Dickson

A relaxed pizzeria specialising in authentic Napoli-style pizza, with in-house made mozzarella and burrata. Handmade dough and simple ingredients are baked in Canberra's only true Neapolitan wood-fired brick oven.

THE DUXTON



The Duxton in O'Connor

The local's local bringing fun to the suburbs. Dine in the bistro, drink in the front sports bar and outdoor patio, or head up to Canberra's only true rooftop terrace featuring its own bar, grass underfoot and retractable roof.

TAPHOUSE



Dickson Taphouse in Dickson

With an ambition to tap 800 beers in a year, Dickson Taphouse is the Inner North's newest watering hole. Food has a focus on sustainability, featuring local produce and Italian classics in a dining room with lush green wallpaper.



EDGAR'S

Edgar's in Ainslie

A laid-back café and gastro pub, Edgar's is often the bustling heart of Ainslie Shops. Grab coffee and brekkie in the morning, a burger over lunch or catch live sport in the evening with a selection of beers and gastronomical fare.



WINE HOUSE

The Canberra Wine House in Dickson

Inspired by a love for all things local, The Canberra Wine House hosts a magnificent wine bar, a tapas menu of entirely local produce, and bottleshop dedicated solely to wines produced within the local region.

Pilot in Ainslie

In a small dining room at the Ainslie Shops, Pilot offers the 'Pilot Menu' each night, and a set menu for lunch. Menu and drinks are forever changing to showcase seasonal produce, and nostalgic flavours in complex dishes.

THE LOFT




The Loft Bar & Living Room in O'Connor
